To insure a MPCCI crop following AF, you cannot destroy the AF crop before the beginning of the last selected interval, however waiver of the last interval is possible. Please watch required "destroy" interval (15 or 35 days) to have an insurable MPCCI crop (TX, OK, NM) or make sure the first crop has not headed (KS, CO, NE).

Acreage reports are due by the 5th day following the end of planting month to be insured. The insured can elect to insure some or all AF acres planted in a season. Only those acres appearing on a timely signed acreage report will have insurance attached.

Eligibility in the next crop year is dependent on the intervals chosen. Overlapping intervals are not allowed. You cannot plant before the beginning of the last selected interval.
